Welcome to the SBC Midwest Performance Measurements web site.

February 2004 performance results for SBC Midwest performance measurements are now available.

Business Rules:

The SBC Midwest Performance Measurements User Guide Version 2.0 has been posted, exactly as filed, and details 2003 Six-Month Review agreed-to (color-lined) changes. Also posted is a clean copy of Version 2.0 with all track (agreed-to) changes accepted. The SBC/Ameritech Performance Measurement User Guide Version 1.9 will continue to be posted until all 2003 Six-Month Review changes have been implemented. Recalculated and Reposted Performance Measures:

Listed below are the measures for which previously reported results have been recalculated and reposted. SBC Ameritech makes available a listing of the recalculated and reposted performance measurement results that have also been restated (changed from the originally posted result) in the Reports section of this website. These reports are available for both CLEC-aggregate results and CLEC-specific results, and are accessed in the same manner as existing performance measurement reports.

- July 2003 data for PM MI 14 has been recalculated and reposted to report the data by the company entering the trouble ticket, not by the owner of the circuit at the time the trouble is entered.

Please note:

- The display for February results for PM 7.1 for the "ALL" disaggregation have been redisplayed to show "the percent of mechanized completions returned within one day of completion" and a benchmark of 97%. Previously, the "ALL" disaggregations was displaying "the percent of mechanized completions not returned within one day of completion" against a 3% benchmark
- The display change limitations noted on the February 20, 2004 News Page continue for this months posting. With this change the affiliate results will only appear in the column labeled "Affiliate". In the past the affiliate results were replicated in the Retail column when there were no Retail results and the affiliate data was used for generation of the z-value. The exceptions to this change with the current display are DSL and Broadband DSL line sharing disaggregations of PMs 55, 55.3, 56, 58-63, 65-67 and 69 as well as PMs 1.1, 1.3, MI 4, MI 10 and MI 16. For those measures the affiliate results are also reported in the Retail column. SBC Midwest is working to address this display issue and will provide notification via this web page when this enhancement is completed. The issue has no impact on determination of pass or fail, or on payment of remedies, for the individual measures.
